A NEW LIBERTY CHAPTER: NORTHWEST GOSPELFEST

Fifteen years, nearly 2000 concerts, and over 750,000 miles later, Liberty Quartet is still celebrating the incredible message of redemption through song across the United States and Canada. It's hard to believe that this November will mark fifteen years for Liberty Quartet! The ministry, founded out of a choir directed by Royce Mitchell at Boise First Nazarene, has become the face of Southern Gospel music in the west. Liberty's driving passion from the very beginning was to deliver a presentation that, though coupling quality music with humor, was first and foremost about ministry. While times have changed, members have changed, and the transportation methods have changed, the resounding theme of "it's all about ministry" has remained constant.

Liberty Quartet will celebrate fifteen years of ministry, miracles, and music in conjunction with its Family Fest weekend in September. This will be a new chapter in the development of Liberty's promotion of music in the Treasure Valley. One of the first annual events that Liberty sponsored was the Idaho Homecoming. In time, the name was changed to Family Fest and in the last few years the event has seen tremendous growth. There have been increasing requests to make this event a weekend festival of sorts and Liberty Quartet feels that now is the time to make this happen. The 1st Annual Northwest Gospelfest to be held September 24-26 in Idaho's Treasure Valley will feature the Family Fest concert held on Friday evening and a Worship Celebration concert on Saturday evening, celebrating Liberty's 15th Anniversary. In addition to the two concerts, attendees can be part of an Artist Reception held prior to Friday's concert; a golf tournament Saturday morning; a ladies brunch on Saturday morning; "Dinner On The Grounds" with

Liberty Quartet on Saturday afternoon; and a worship service with the quartet and the Nampa First Nazarene choir, and Pastor Kent Conrad on Sunday morning.

The 2010 Family Fest features the rich family vocals of the Talley Trio and the incredible harmonies of Christian music's number one a cappella group, RESCUE. Other groups featured at Family Fest will be The Ritchey Music Group, Homeland Harmony Quartet, and the amazing Homecoming Choir under the direction of Gerald VanOrder. Of course, as your hosts, Liberty Quartet will be singing throughout the evening. Saturday's Worship Celebration and 15th Anniversary concert will feature every member of Liberty Quartet, both present and past. You'll enjoy the multimedia presentations that highlight some of the great stories from the road, hear classic songs from the good old days, and join with Liberty in a grand concert of worship.
